Before registering on emergency medicine courses for Fellowship of ACRRM training purposes, please ensure that you have read and understood ACRRM's *Policy Statement – Emergency Medicine Course Requirements*.

Registrars enrolling in ACRRM vocational training from 2009 onwards must successfully complete **either** two accredited Tier 1 courses **or** one accredited Tier 1 course and two accredited Tier 2 courses.

Registrars who enrolled in ACRRM vocational training prior to 2009 must successfully complete two emergency courses, preferably from the Tier 1 accredited group, but individual cases may be assessed on their merits.
