

QScript Go Live!! – 27 September 2021

QScript is Queensland's read-only, real-time prescription monitoring system that notifies health practitioners to review a patient's monitored medicine prescription history at the point of care. QScript is a clinical tool that provides information to prescribers and dispensers when making decisions about prescribing or dispensing a monitored medicine.

QScript will be available on 27 September 2021 when the *Medicines and Poisons Act 2019* commences. At this time, authorised prescribers and dispensers will be able to log in and use QScript to review a patient's monitored medicine prescription history when prescribing or dispensing monitored medicines.

Under the new *Medicines and Poisons Act 2019* (section 41), from 28 October 2021 it will be a requirement for relevant health practitioners to check the patient's QScript record before:

- prescribing a monitored medicine
- dispensing a monitored medicine
- giving a treatment dose of a monitored medicine.

Have you registered?

The following health practitioners can register now.

- medical practitioners
- pharmacists
- nurse practitioners
- endorsed midwives
- dentists
- podiatric surgeons and endorsed podiatrists.

These health practitioners can register for QScript by:

- clicking the QScript registration link sent to their AHPRA-registered email address; or
- heading to the QScript registration portal at <https://register.qscript.health.qld.gov.au>

From 27 September 2021, health practitioners who have registered for QScript will be able to use their login details to access the system.
