

Delphi Panel Invitation: Complex Prescribing in General Practice

We are inviting experienced **Rural GPs** and **Rural Generalists** to participate in a national Delphi panel to achieve consensus on medication related clinical indicators for managing patients with complex prescribing needs.

What's involved: The process involves completing

- Up to three online survey rounds
- ~130 minutes per round (including pre-read and reflections for CPD points)

Time commitment: May–December 2026, with a **\$100 gift card for each round completed.**

Participation attracts 6.5 **CPD hours** (ACRRM activity number 1521342), *1.5 hours performance review, 1.5 hours educational activity and 3.5 hours outcome measurement*
